

AQUIFER

A layer of rock, sand or earth that contains water or allows water to pass through it.

LOY YANG

An open cut mine located south of Traralgon whose Indigenous name means 'big eel'.

COAL MINE

Where coal is extracted from the ground.

POWER STATION

An industrial facility that generates electric power from burning coal

BROWN COAL

A soft, brown combustible sedimentary rock formed from naturally compressed peat, often referred to as lignite.

HAZELWOOD

An open-cut mine located south of Morwell which is now closed for rehabilitation.

LATROBE RIVER

The longest waterway in the West Gippsland catchment.

LATROBE VALLEY

An inland geographical district and urban area of the Gippsland region.

GROUNDWATER

Water that is found below the ground surface.

YALLOURN

An open cut mine located east of Moe.
